INTRODUCTION

The Al-Qasim-JUNIOR YOUTH CLUB (QJYC) announces its first ever Saturday Junior Youth Workshop, a weekly program that builds upon the artistic and aesthetic talents of junior youth, in order to help them internalize and promote Islamic values within their lives. The program is divided into three (3) semesters: Fall, Spring and Summer. The program will begin with a shortened Summer Semester to start on Saturday July 24th. This is a great opportunity to instill in Junior youth strong Islamic identities by creating and enhancing their talents within the IEC community and other Islamic programs and events.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKSHOPS

Poetry, Noha and Qasida Workshop

The Poetry, Nohas and Qasidas Workshop will teach junior youth how to use their creative talents to design their own genuine elegies in English and the language of their choice. Well-known and traditional nohas and qasidas will be taught. Additionally, junior youth will rehearse nohas and qasidas in order to enrich IEC programs and events, ceremonies and other venues, with their unique talents. This workshop prepares junior youth to be creative in using the love of Qur'an and Ahlul Bayt to produce wonderful masterpieces.

Du'as and Ziyarats Workshop

Junior youth will learn how to recite the most widely-read du'as and ziyarats so they can always participate in IEC programs and events. Junior youth will learn how to recite Du'a Kumayl, Du'a Tawassul, Du'as for every prayer, Du'as in the Month of Rajab, Sha'ban and Ramadhan, and with proper Arabic pronunciation. They will also learn the English translations of each Du'a and Ziyarat. Junior youth will also learn how to recite Hadith Kisaa, and Ziyarat Ashura, Arbaeen, Ziyarat of Prophet, Al-Zahra, the Imams (as) and more. Instructors will also teach junior youth to be creative in their recitation to make the du'as and ziyarats more eloquent. Du'as and Ziyarats will be taught from materials with English, Arabic and Transliteration.

Arts and Crafts Workshop

Junior Youth can enhance their talents through the Arts and Crafts workshop. Learn how to design elegant murals, wall hangings, clay pottery, paintings and more. Junior Youth will create various artwork to be displayed in the IEC. These works of art will be thematic for the Birthdays and Shahadat of Ahlul Bayt (as), especially for Muharram, special historical events, and more. Junior youth will have the opportunity to compete for the best art work.

Plays and Performances Workshop

Junior Youth can gain or enhance their talents in Islamic role-playing, by imitating the noble aspects learned from Ahlul Bayt (as) and the Prophets (as). Junior youth will learn how to act, and enhance their presentation and communication skills. They will enrich the community with plays for the special events at IEC, and perform at other events. Junior youth will learn about lighting, and sets. They will increase their knowledge of Islam through reliving the lives of Prophet (sawa) and his Ahlul Bayt (as). Junior youth will learn the importance of playing their roles well no matter what role they are given.

Quizzes, Debates and Speeches Workshop

Junior Youth will apply their Islamic learning to create and present speeches. A subject will be introduced and they will have to research and learn the answers for quiz competitions. A topic will be given, and junior youth have to choose a side, and debate it in front of the IEC community or other Islamic event. Junior Youth will learn presentation and communication skills.
